### CYNGOR SIR DDINBYCH ESGOBAETH WRECSAM

#### HYSBYSIAD YNGLŶN Â CHYNNIG I AD-DREFNU YSGOLION DAN DDEDDF SAFONAU A THREFNIADAETH YSGOLION (CYMRU) 2013

Hysbysir drwy hyn, yn unol ag Adran 41 yn Neddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru) 2013 (y **Ddeddf**) a Chod Trefniadaeth Ysgolion, bod Esgobaeth Wrecsam, Bishop's House, Ffordd Sonlli, Wrecsam, LL13 7EW (yr **Esgobaeth**), wedi ymgynghori â'r unigolion angenrheidiol, yn cynnig:

- Sefydlu ysgol Gatholig newydd cyfrwng Saesneg, wirfoddol a gynorthwyr ar gyfer bechgyn a merched 3-16 oed ar Cefndy Road, y Rhyl o 1 Medi 2019 ymlaen. Bydd yn cael ei chynnal gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych.

Mae'r cynnig hwn wedi ei gysylltu ar cynigion isod i gau Ysgol Gynradd Gatholig Santes Fair ac Ysgol Uwchradd Gatholig y Bendigaid Edward Jones.

Hysbysir drwy hyn, yn unol ag Adran 43 yn Neddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru) 2013 (y **Ddeddf**) a Chod Trefniadaeth Ysgolion, bod Cyngor Sir Ddinbych, Neuadd y Sir, Rhuthun, Sir Ddinbych, LL15 1YN (y **Cyngor**), wedi ymgynghori â'r unigolion angenrheidiol, yn cynnig:

- Cau Ysgol Mair/Ysgol Gynradd Gatholig Santes Fair, St Margaret's Drive, y Rhyl, LL18 2HY, sef ysgol cyfrwng Saesneg wirfoddol a gynorthwyr, sydd ar hyn o bryd yn cael ei chynnal gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych, ar 31 Awst 2019;
- Cau Ysgol Uwchradd Gatholig y Bendigaid Edward Jones, Cefndy Road, y Rhyl, LL18 2EU, sef ysgol cyfrwng Saesneg wirfoddol a gynorthwyr, sydd ar hyn o bryd yn cael ei chynnal gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych, ar 31 Awst 2019.

Mae'r cynigion hyn wedi ei cysylltu a'r cynnig uchod i sefydlu ysgol Gatholig newydd cyfrwng Saesneg, wirfoddol a gynorthwyr ar Ffordd Cefndy, Rhyl. Gan bod cysylltiad rhwng y cynigion uchod ni fydd cynnig yn cael ei symud ymlaen os na fydd y cynigion i gyd yn mynd ymlaen.

Rydym yn cynnig y bydd yr adeilad newydd yn barod erbyn mis Medi 2019. Os oes oedi wrth adeiladu'r ysgol newydd ac os nad oes modd symud i'r adeilad newydd ar y dyddiad hwnnw, bydd yr ysgol newydd yn cael ei sefydlu yn yr adeiladau presennol nes bydd adeilad newydd yr ysgol yn barod i'w ddefnyddio.

Cynhaliodd y Cyngor a'r Esgobaeth gyfnod ymgynghori cyn penderfynu cyhoeddi'r cynigion hyn. Mae adroddiad ymgynghori, sy'n cynnwys crynodeb o'r materion a godwyd yn yr ymgynghoriad, ymatebion y Cyngor a'r Esgobaeth a safbwyntiau Estyn, ar gael ar wefan Cyngor Sir Ddinbych:

Yr awdurdod derbyn fydd corff llywodraethu'r ysgol newydd ac fe fydd yn gyfrifol am drefniadau derbyn yr ysgol.

Yn y flwyddyn ysgol gyntaf y bydd y cynigion yn cael eu rhoi ar waith, nifer derbyn yr ysgol newydd fydd:

Blwyddyn Derbyn hyd at Flwyddyn 6 - 60  
Blwyddyn 7 hyd at Flwyddyn 11 - 100\*

Er mwyn sicrhau bod digon o leoedd i'r disgyblion, bydd lle i 420 o ddisgyblion cynradd a 500 o rai uwchradd yn yr ysgol newydd. Bydd lle i 60 yn y ddarpariaeth feithrin.

Bydd disgyblion sydd ar y gofrestr pan fydd Ysgol Mair ac Ysgol y Bendigaid Edward Jones yn cau'n cael eu trosglwyddo'n awtomatig (yn amodol ar ddewis y rhieni). Bydd yr holl dderbyniadau eraill yn cael eu gwneud drwy drefniadau derbyn y corff llywodraethu. Nid yw'r rhain yn ystyried rhyw, dawn na gallu'r plentyn.


Bydd trefniadau cludiant o'r cartref i'r ysgol ar gyfer disgyblion presennol Ysgol Mair/Santes Fair ac Ysgol y Bendigaid Edward Jones yn parhau yr un fath yn yr ysgol newydd arfaethedig, yn unol â Pholisi Cludiant y Cyngor o'r Cartref i'r Ysgol fel ag y maent ar y dyddiad y gweithredir y cynnig.

(Nid yw'r nodyn esboniadol hwn yn rhan o'r Hysbysiad ond caiff ei gynnig fel esboniad)

- \*Y rhif derbyn ar gyfer lleoedd uwchradd fydd nifer y lleoedd sydd ar gael ar ôl ystyried yr holl ddisgyblion sydd ym Mlwyddyn 6. Er enghraifft, os oes lle i 100 ym Mlwyddyn 7 a bod gennych chi 60 o ddisgyblion ar y gofrestr ym mlwyddyn 6, eich nifer derbyn i lleoedd uwchradd fyddai 40.
- Categori iaith yr ysgol newydd arfaethedig, fel y diffiniwyd gan Lywodraeth Cymru yn ôl darpariaeth cyfrwng Cymraeg, fydd Categori 5 (cyfrwng Saesneg yn bennaf) ar gyfer yr elfen 3-11 oed a Chategori 4 (cyfrwng Saesneg yn bennaf) ar gyfer elfen 11-16 oed.
- Nodwyd y rhesymeg dros y cynnig hwn mewn dogfen ymgynghori â rannwyd fis Chwefror 2017.
- Mae'r Ddeddf yn rhoi'r pŵer i'r Cyngor allu cau ysgol gymunedol a phŵer i'r Esgobaeth agor ysgol wirfoddol a gynorthwyr. Yn unol â hynny, mae'r Cyngor a'r Esgobaeth wedi cydweithio ar y cynnig a byddant yn gweithio gyda'i gilydd i'w weithredu os penderfynir gwneud hynny.
- Bydd cyllid dirprwyedig ar gyfer yr ysgol newydd arfaethedig yn unol â fformiwla ariannu leol y Cyngor ar gyfer ysgolion.
- Bydd corff llywodraethu dros dro'r ysgol yn cael ei sefydlu cyn y dyddiad gweithredu ac fe fydd yn gyfrifol am; benodi Pennaeth, enwi'r ysgol newydd, sefydlu'r weledigaeth a'r ethos, creu trefniadau rhedeg yr ysgol, gan gynnwys y cwricwlwm a llety, a bod â chyfrifoldeb dros agor yr ysgol newydd, nes bydd corff llywodraethu newydd wedi'i ffurfio.
- Mae copïau o'r ddogfen ymgynghori a'r Polisi Cludiant o'r Cartref i'r Ysgol ar gael gan Tim Moderneiddio Addysg o'r cyfeiriad a nodir yn yr hysbysiad.
- Mae'r hysbysiad hwn yn nodi dechrau cyfnod gwrthwynebu o 28 diwrnod o **20 Mehefin 2017 hyd at 17 Gorffennaf 2017** ac mae'n cynnwys y cyfeiriad ar gyfer cyflwyno gwrthwynebiadau'n ysgrifenedig.

## STATUTORY NOTICE

### DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL THE DIOCESE OF WREXHAM

#### **NOTICE OF SCHOOL REORGANISATION PROPOSAL UNDER THE SCHOOL STANDARDS AND ORGANISATION (WALES) ACT 2013**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 41 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 (the **Act**) and the School Organisation Code that The Diocese of Wrexham, Bishops House, Sontley Road, Wrexham, LL13 7EW (the **Diocese**), having consulted such persons as required, propose to:

- Establish a new English Medium, Voluntary Aided Catholic school for boys and girls aged 3-16 years old at Cefndy Road, Rhyl from 1 September 2019, this will be maintained by Denbighshire County Council.

This proposal is linked to the proposals below to discontinue St Marys Catholic Primary School and Blessed Edward Jones Catholic High School.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 43 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 (the **Act**) and the School Organisation Code that Denbighshire County Council of County Hall, Ruthin, Denbighshire LL15 1YN (the **Council**), having consulted such persons as required, propose to:

- Discontinue Ysgol Mair/ St. Marys Catholic Primary school, St. Margaret's Drive, Rhyl, LL18 2HY, an English Medium, Voluntary Aided school currently maintained by Denbighshire County Council from 31 August 2019;
- Discontinue Blessed Edward Jones Catholic High school, Cefndy Road, Rhyl, LL18 2EU, an English Medium, Voluntary Aided school currently maintained by Denbighshire County Council from 31 August 2019.

These proposals are linked to the proposal above to establish a new English Medium, Voluntary Aided Catholic school at Cefndy Road, Rhyl. As the proposals above are linked, no proposal will be taken forward unless all proposals proceed.

We are proposing that the new build will be ready by September 2019. If there is a delay in the new school build and occupation of the new building is not possible on that date, the new school will be established in the existing buildings until such time that the new school build is ready and available for occupation.

The Council and the Diocese undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish these proposals. The Governing Body of the new school will be the admissions authority and will be responsible for the school's admissions arrangements. The admission number for the new school in the first school year in which the proposals will be implemented will be as follows:

Reception to Year 6 - 60  
Year 7 to Year 11 – 100\*

To ensure pupil places are maintained the new school's pupil capacity will be 420 for the primary and 500 for the secondary elements. There will be provision for 60 nursery places.

Admission to the new school will be via automatic transfer for full time pupils on roll at the point of closure at Ysgol Mair/ St. Mary's and Blessed Edward Jones (subject to any expression of parental preference). All other admissions will be via the Governing Body's admission arrangements, which do not take account of the sex, aptitude or ability of the child.


The home to school transport arrangements for pupils currently at Ysgol Mair/ St. Marys and Blessed Edward Jones will remain the same at the proposed new school in accordance with the Council's Home to School Transport Policy as at the date of implementation of the proposal.

Within a period of 28 days after the date of publication of these proposals, that is to say by **17 July 2017** any person may object to the proposal (the **Objection Period**).

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This explanatory note does not form part of the Notice but is offered by way of explanation)

- \*The admission number for secondary will be the number of vacancies available after factoring in all the Year 6 pupils. For example if the Year 7 capacity is 100 and you have 60 pupils on roll in Year 6, your secondary admission number would be 40.
- The language category of the proposed new school, as defined by the Welsh Government according to Welsh medium provision will be Category 5 (Predominantly English Medium) for the 3-11 element and Category 4 (Predominantly English medium) for the 11-16 element.
- The rationale for this proposal was set out in a consultation document circulated in February 2017.
- The Act gives the Council the power to close a community school and the Diocese the power to open a voluntary aided school. Accordingly, the Council and the Diocese have worked jointly on the proposal and will work together to implement it should it be determined.
- Delegated funding for the proposed new school will be in accordance with the Council's local funding formula for schools.
- The Temporary Governing Body of the new school will be established prior to the implementation date and will be responsible for; the appointment of Headteacher, naming of the new school, establishing the vision and ethos, making organisational arrangements including curriculum and accommodation and have the responsibility for the opening of the new school until such time as the new governing body is in place.
- Copies of the consultation document and Home to School Transport Policy are available from Modernising Education Team at the address set out in the Notice.
- This Notice marks the start of a 28 day objection period from **20 June 2017 to 17 July 2017** and sets out the address to which objections in writing may be submitted.
